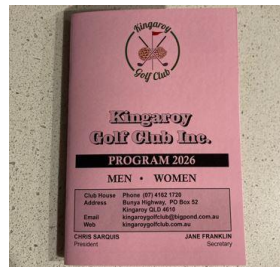
Leave of Absence
