Document Name	KGC Small Electric Golf Vehicle Policy
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Purpose

The Kingaroy Golf Club (KGC) is committed to ensuring the safety of members, visitors, guests, staff and the public.

The following guidelines apply to the use of all small electric golf vehicles (walk-behind electric buggies, 3- and 4-wheel scooters) while they are being used on the Kingaroy Golf Course.

The policy does not apply to electric golf carts (please see [KGC Motorised Cart Policy](#)).

Walk-behind Electric Buggies

1. Operators must ensure the safety of pedestrians, flora and fauna.
2. Any damage to people, wildlife or property must be immediately reported to a member of the [KGC Management Committee](#) or to the Bar Staff.
3. Operators must always give way to pedestrians.
4. These buggies can be taken into the car park area. Operators are to ensure that they have hands on the buggy while in the car park to minimize the possibility of collision.
5. These buggies can be stored in the buggy storage area or in buggy sheds. **However lithium ion batteries must not be charged or stored on KGC property due to fire risk.** Owners are required to detach the battery and take it with them when the buggy is not in use.

3- and 4-wheel Scooters

1. Operators must ensure the safety of pedestrians, flora and fauna.
2. Operators must comply with directional and speed signs, stakes, and ropes marking areas requiring course care.
3. Scooters must not be driven within 10 metres of tees or greens or between bunkers and greens, nor are they to be left standing near to bunkers and greens. Scooters are to be driven around the outside of greenside bunkers.
4. Scooters must not be driven through ground under repair (GUR).
5. Scooter operators must always obey all alerts from geofencing software and signage on and around the course as to direction and speed.
6. Scooter operators must comply with conditions specified for rounds such as Honour Board events.
7. Scooter operators must comply with restrictions to the use of motorised carts on the course in exceptional weather conditions.
8. For safety reasons, scooters should not be driven within the car park. They can be unloaded near the white picket fence near the 9th hole.
9. Any damage to people, wildlife or property must be immediately reported to a member of the [KGC Management Committee](#) or to the Bar Staff.

6. Scooters can be stored in the buggy storage area in the Clubhouse or in buggy sheds. **However, lithium ion batteries must not be charged or stored on KGC property due to fire risk.** Owners are required to detach the battery and take it with them when the scooter is not in use.
10. Operators must comply with directions from any member of the KGC Management Committee that address safety issues where unsafe, erratic or reckless driving is reported or observed.
11. The KGC Management Committee reserves the right to suspend a member, either temporarily, or permanently, from operating a scooter on the Club property when erratic driving endangers others on the course.

Insurance Considerations

1. All owners of small electric golf vehicles being stored or driven at the Kingaroy Golf Club are responsible for insuring their own vehicle. Damage to vehicles or personal electronic devices (eg phones, watches, ipads, range finders, etc) is not covered by the Golf Australia Players' Personal Liability Insurance.
2. Scooter owners are fully liable for any injuries or damages caused by their vehicle while on the Kingaroy Golf Course.
